Blue Essentials for Health

BURRIS LOGISTICS AND YOU--WORKING OUR WAY TOWARD BETTER HEALTH

Burriss Logistics knew that to have the best possible workforce, those team members would need to be healthy, feeling well and encouraged to take steps to make that happen. Burriss put programs in place that would encourage better health by helping us be more aware of our “numbers.” Our Healthways Program does just that. By logging onto <https://blueessentialsforhealth.embrace.healthways.com> team members participating in Blue Cross Blue Shield of Delaware, as of January 1, 2011 who have been with Burriss six months or more at January 1, 2011, are eligible to take part in the Blue Essentials Wellness Portal. This portal is available 24/7 all year for us to log in and take advantage of the wealth of health information that is at our fingertips. The portal offers encouragement, cooking tips, menus, and ideas to make stressful situations a little easier to handle. It definitely makes the moments you spend in the site worth your while.

It's officially Spring and this brings our Healthways Biometric Screenings to our locations. Many of our facilities are now completed and anxiously awaiting their results. We have some locations that will be holding their testing in the very near future. Our goal is to see our number of participants increase. In 2009 we had approximately 325 participants Corporate wide. 2010 brought over 1000 participants, which was phenomenal. 2011 promises to raise the numbers of team members willing to take time for themselves to “know their numbers” and be proactive about them. Please be sure to complete your Well Being Assessment in order to qualify for the great incentives offered.

Please have your spouse complete their Well Being Assessment (WBA) if they are covered under your policy. Without their participation, you will not be eligible for incentives which will be awarded in early July 2011. Failure to complete your WBA (and your spouse's, if applicable) will result in a \$10.00 per week increase in your BCBS premium in July, 2011.

THE HEALTHY REWARD INCENTIVES ARE:

\$100.00 IF YOU TEST NEGATIVE FOR NICOTINE-Or have physician's statement that you are under their care in a smoking cessation program.
\$100.00 IF YOUR CHOLESTEROL IS UNDER 200-Or you are under physician supervised care for high cholesterol-physician's note required.
\$100.00 IF YOUR BMI (Body Mass Index) is 30 or under, or if you have reduced your number by 10% since our 2010 testing!

Burriss locations are encouraged to have various programs throughout the year such as: Lunch & Learns focusing on different health topics each month, Walking Programs & Weight Loss Programs to encourage our team members to support each other as a team while losing that extra weight that may need to go. Burriss offers \$500.00 to the male and female team member losing the largest percentage of body weight—twice a year. That is a great reward!! Get going...It's not too late to get started!!

Today's economy is a challenge. Taking good care of you and your family's health is one of the best ways to beat health care costs. Keeping healthier helps Burriss continue to give us super coverage at extremely reasonable rates. As team members, we are fortunate to have such extraordinary health benefits. All of us are aware that at other workplaces the cost for benefits is high and not nearly the quality of ours. Let's work together (which is what we do best, right?) to make our facilities models of ...Health, Safety is #1 environments!

Can't wait to see our gang again next year!

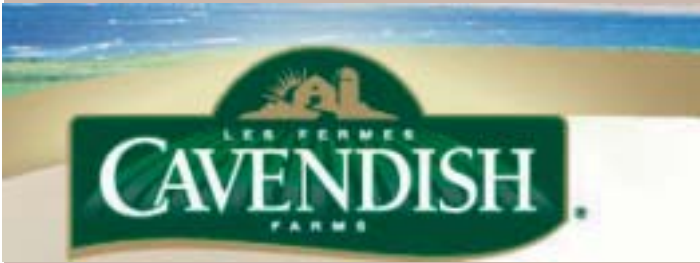
